As weblog readers know, Judge Davis recently denied z4's request for entry of a permanent injunction based on the jury verdict. Citing the Supreme Court's recent statements as to the availability of injunctive relief in a patent case in *eBay v. MercExchange*, Judge Davis found that the traditional factors did not support entry of an injunction in that case.
