2. Critical Issues in 2.5 -- Your Assistance is Needed

Hi everyone,

One of the goals for the 2.5 release is to resolve not only the JIRAs flagged as blockers but to also knock out the critical items. I believe trying to resolve all filed items in JIRA to be a bit ambitious so it is my hope that we can at least target and resolve the blockers and critical specifically reported against a 2.5 tag. (If the community were to prove me wrong on the ambitious point, I would surely welcome that!)

I've been in contact with many of the project leads and most of the issues are on track to be resolved before Dec 13th. That said, that are some issues that teams do no have resources to resolve or could use assistance in resolving. I am requesting assistance from the community in resolving these issues. I believe it's an accurate statement to say that advancing the quality of the software is on the minds of many in the community. We're not going to be able to do this without rolling our sleeves up and working together. If you have the expertise needed to resolve one of these issues, I implore you to assist.

4. 2007 Sakai Board Elections: Polls Are Open

The Sakai Board and the Elections Work Group are pleased to announce that the polls are open for the election for three vacant positions on the Sakai Foundation Board of Directors. The online voting site is now available to voting members (one representative from each member organization), and will remain so through Friday, November 23. Results of this election will be announced in early December and new Board members will take their positions at the Sakai Conference. The Sakai Foundation is dedicated to the design and development of collaborative, open source code, software efforts that are targeted at supporting education, research and related scholarly activities. The Board of Directors provides leadership for the Sakai Foundation by serving the interests of the entire Sakai community, promoting the objectives of the Sakai Foundation, representing and coordinating Foundation projects, ensuring that project management is consistent with the Foundation's mission, and that the Foundation operates within its fiscal resources. 5. rSmart Soliciting Feedback on New CMS Comparative Matrix

The rSmart Group has recently created and contributed a document that can help new users transition to Sakai from other CMS/LMSes. Because each system has its own names for various tools and functions, new Sakai users may not immediately understand that, for example, the Sakai Announcements tool does roughly the same thing as the Desire2Learn News tool they've used in the past. To ease the transition, The rSmart Group has created Similar Tools in Various CMSes and LMSes (http://bugs.sakaiproject.org/confluence/download/attachments/5315/Similar+Tools+in+Various+CMSes+and+LMSes.xls?version=1), a table that identifies comparable tools in Sakai, Blackboard Academic Suite, Blackboard Vista, Web CT Campus Edition (up to 4.2), Desire2Learn, Angel Learning with ePortfolio 2.0, and Moodle.

rSmart developed this table based on available marketing materials and user documentation. If you have experience with any of the other LMS/CMSes, please help the community improve the table: Edit entries as needed to correct tool names, add or delete tools if appropriate, etc. This is one of the many cases in which the wisdom of crowds is bound to be better than the wisdom of a few!
