Student Systems

Registrations

Handles all aspects of student registration, including initial course selection, drop/add, wait listing, etc.

Records

Monitors grades, degree clearance, transcript production and all other areas of student record maintenance.

Scheduling and Curriculum

Manages course/room scheduling, and the catalog of all approved courses.

Testudo

Provides a wide range of student services (including drop/add, grade inquiry, address change, student account look-up, financial aid look-up, etc) on the web.

UMEG

Provides for electronic grades submission.

Degree Navigator

Tracks student academic progress and serves as a tool for Advisors.

VENUS

Provides students with a web based course scheduling tool.

Enrollment Verification & Certification

Allows Registrations Office to verify enrollment status to outside agencies, certify athletes to the NCAA, and validate veterans status to the VA.

WebCT

Provides degree tracking information to students and advisors.

Student Account Receivables

Manages the students account receivables process. Includes posting payments, charges; financial accounting system, and generating bills.

Student Accounts Receivable Bad Debt

Manages, separate from the student account receivables system, accounts which have entered into a bad debt.

Student Loan Information

Manages the interface to outsourced system that does creation, billing and collection of Perkins loans offered to students demonstrating need.

Resident Life

Tracks all aspects of student housing assignments, including room management, contract management, and forwarding charges to the student account system.

Orientation

Manages the conduct of the student orientation process, feeding registration, admissions, and student account receivables.

Dining Services

Provides Dining Service with a system to manage meal contracts and plans and bills meal plan charges.

Off-Campus Housing

Provides Student Affairs an online inventory of rooms, apartments, and houses offered for rent.

Undergraduate Admissions

Provides for all aspects of undergraduate application and admission processing, management, and recruiting.

Graduate School

Provides for all aspects of Graduate School application, admission, records processing, and recruiting.

MEGS

Tracks graduate program applications and admission actions. Potentially provides other management functions for graduate students.

Financial Aid

Manages the assignment and payment authorization of funds offered to students demonstrating need for education asistance.

IES

Manages international students, including SEVIS reporting to INS.

DEANS

Provides electronic mail to college and department and other administrative units. Also provides access to other information such as new curricula status, ADVISE, and the faculty/staff directory.

ADVISE

Provides Colleges and Departments with the ability to advise students and do academic audits, search and reports on student course information, monitor seat availability, and produce enrollment management reports.

Division of Letter & Sciences (DLS)

Allows Division of Letter & Sciences (DLS) to track students and their advisors.

Summer School

Provides enrollment and financial information for the Dean of Summer School. Also manages faculty contracts.
