There could still be a good chance for many of the decisions to be driven by the uP community because the Sakai developers still don't have the time to have too much interest for portal issues. We should decide what Sakai content should be rendered in uP portlets and determine how GAPS can be aware of Sakai's groups and sessions. This would allow us to render key Sakai components (or at least doorways to those components) in uP and allow us to render existing uP channels/portlets in conjunction with Sakai content.
